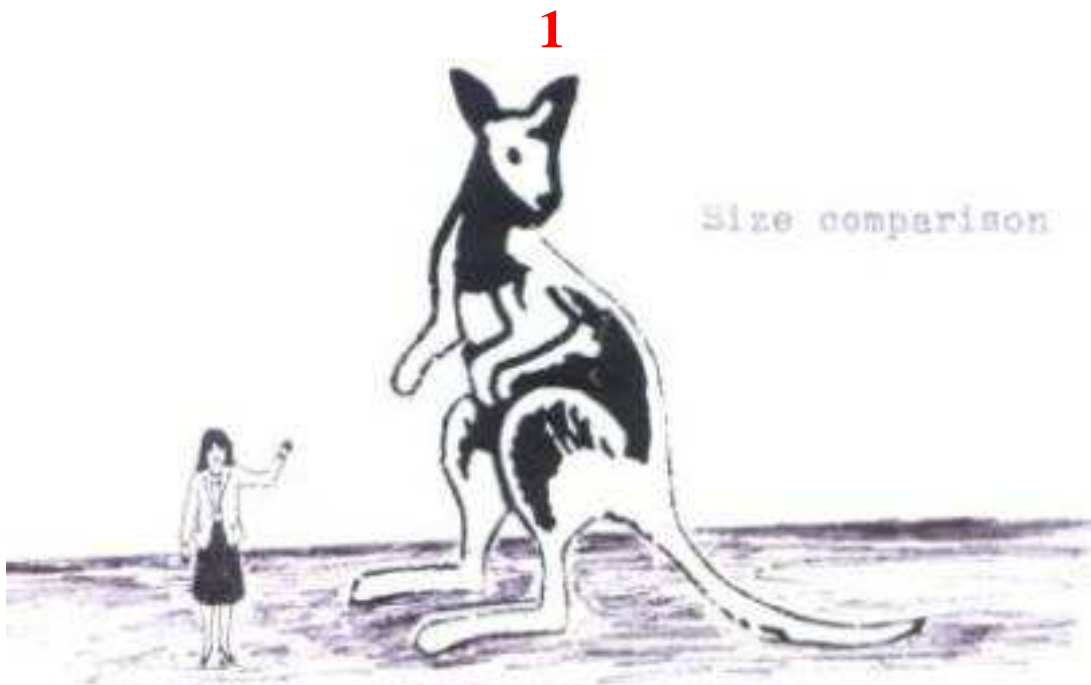

The environmental conditions of the early world supported plant and animal life of fantastic size. The fossil record shows that all terrestrial life has decreased in size.



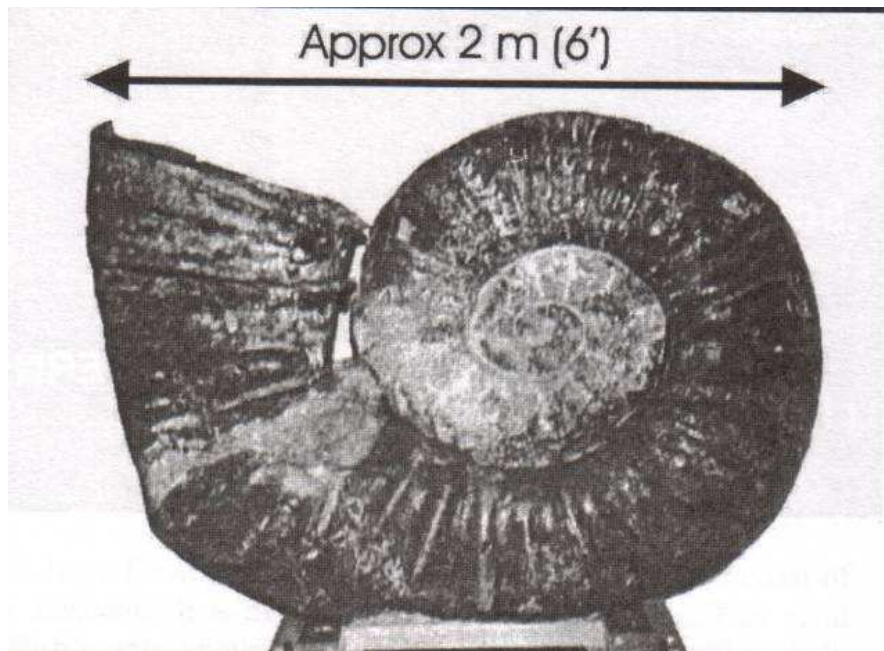
In the past, there were kangaroos as large as today's hipopotamuses, with skulls 3 feet (1 meter) long.

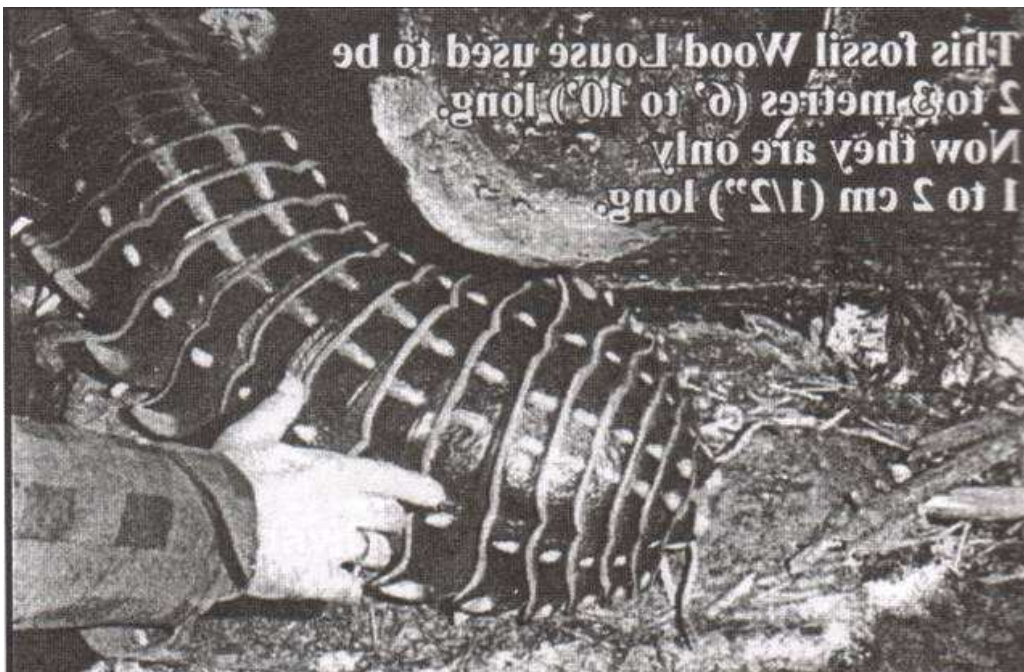

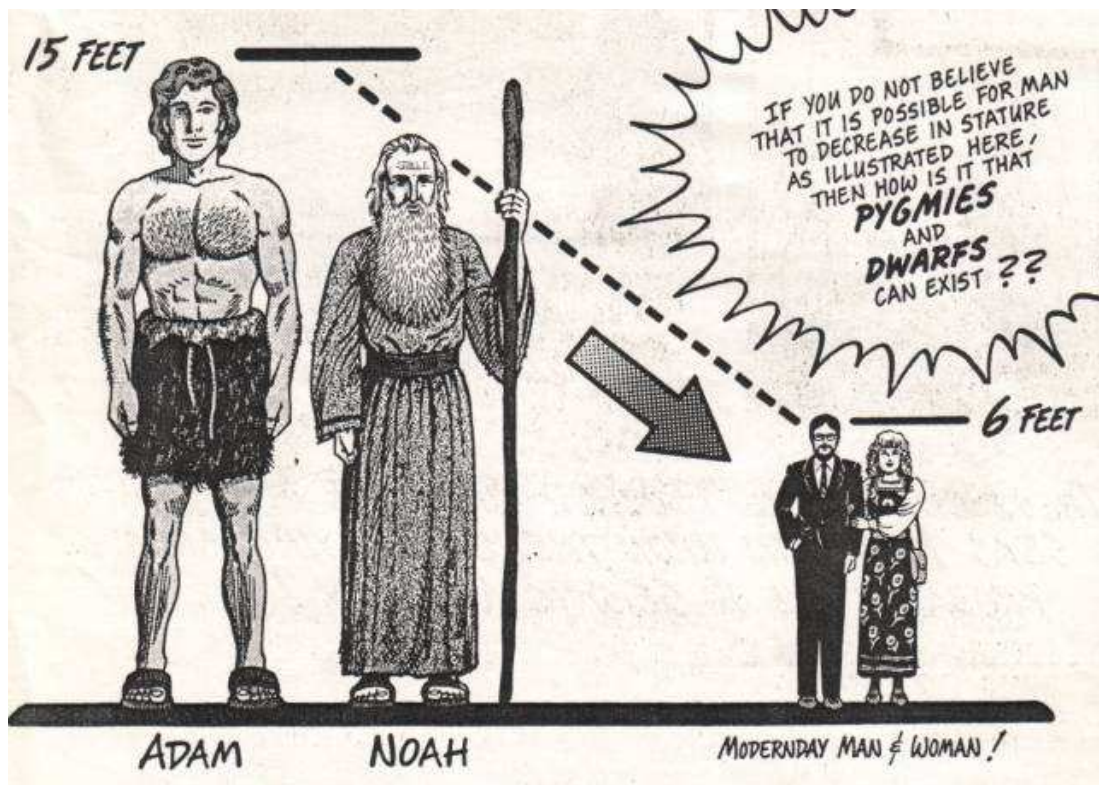

Tassel ferns that once grew over 100 feet (30 meters) tall, today reach only a few feet. (*Creation News*, vol.14 No.1)

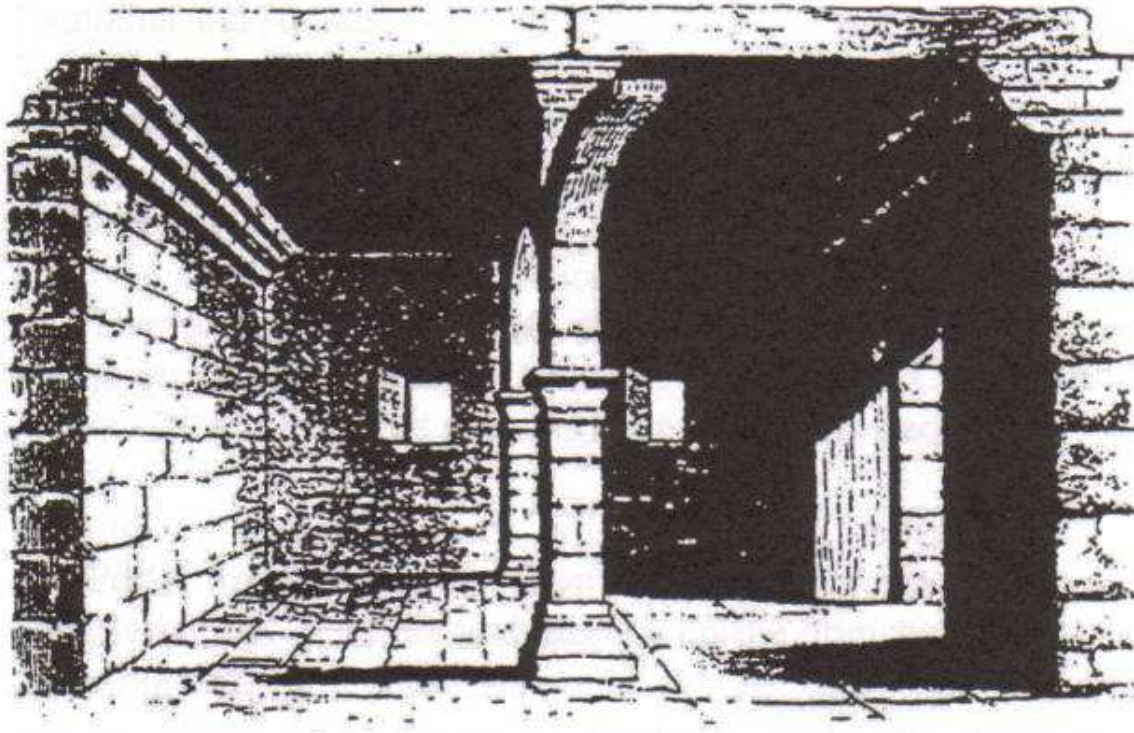
MANKIND

Height decrease also means decrease in total bulk.

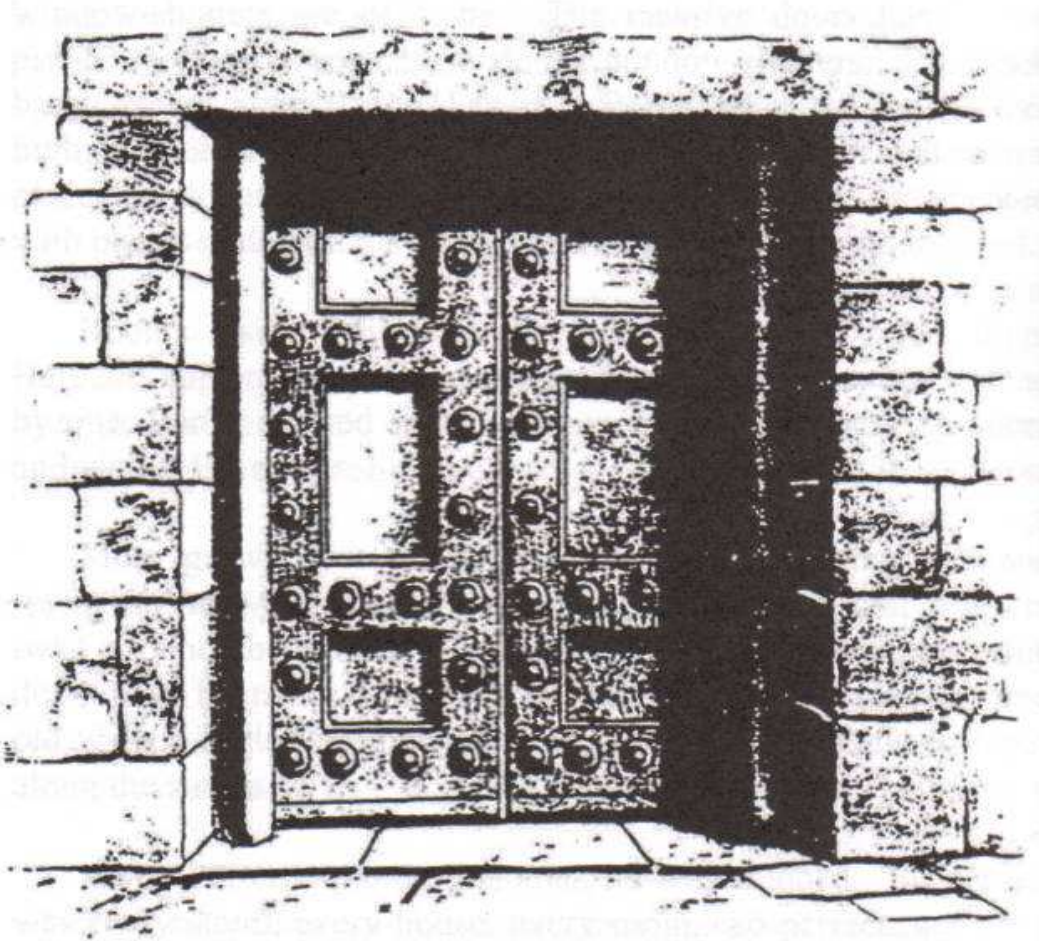

The Bible speaks of the ancient “giants” of the land of Bashan. Nineteenth century explorer, Josiah Porter, penetrated this now-deserted region. He found their empty cities still standing. He opened

doors of their houses. He slept in their now-deserted halls. In *The Lost World of Giants* we describe what he saw. Rooms inside private houses measured up to 20 (6 meters) feet high.

Porter measured doors 9 feet high by 4 ½ feet wide and 10 inches thick (that is, 270 cm by 135 cm by 25 cm). These were indeed cities of giants.

This giant stone axe head was unearthed by Rex Gilroy near Bathurst, NSW, Australia. It is 25 pounds in weight. The man who used it would have been 12 feet (4 meters) tall or over, weighing 500 to 600 pounds.



In the north-eastern province of Xieng Khouang in Laos, outside the town of Phonsavan, is the famous and mysterious Plain of Jars. Hundreds of gigantic stone jars lie scattered across the plain. These ancient jars each weigh several tons. According to local tradition they were made and used by a race of giants



In the Paluxy River, near Glen Rose, Texas, human footprints 21 inches (52.5 cm) long have been excavated.



Also from the Paluxy River, where several strata of human prints with dinosaur prints have been excavated: An ancient woman's footprint is seen next to the foot of a modern man. Indications are that she was approximately 10 feet tall (305 cm tall) and 1,000 pounds (454 kg) in weight. *(Photo by M. Coppedge)*

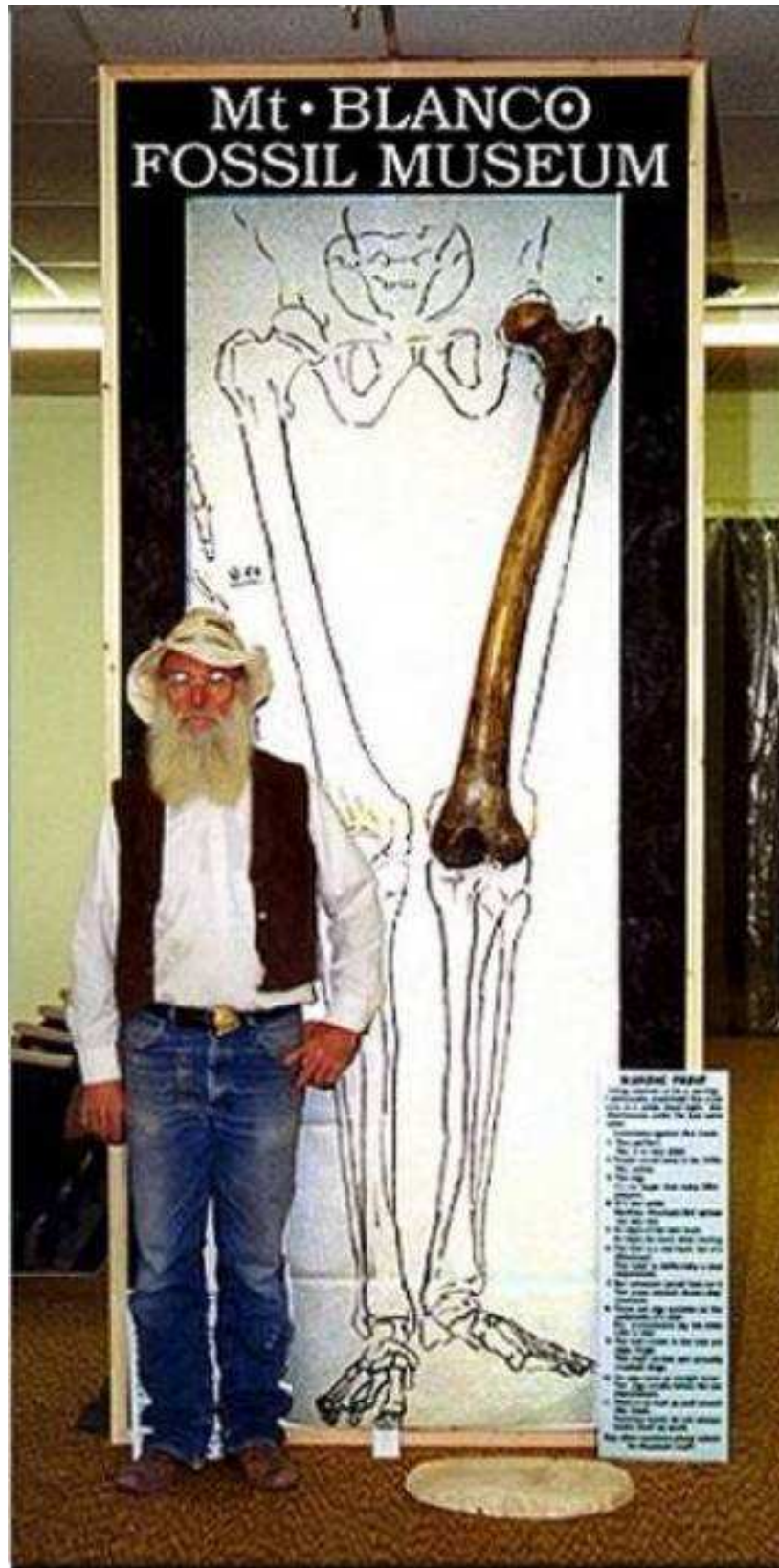


I have personally handled this human finger bone from ancient Turkey, which is more than twice the length of people alive today. The owner of this finger needed to be at least 12 feet (4 meters) tall.

Compare the size of this ancient human toe.



In the late 1950s, during construction in south-east Turkey, many tombs containing the remains of giants were discovered. At two sites the leg bones were measured to be 47.24 inches (120 cm). Joe Taylor, Director of the Mt. Blanco Fossil Museum, in Crosbyton, Texas, was commissioned to

sculpt an anatomically correct, and to scale, human femur of one of these ancient men that had been excavated. The giant stood some 14 to 16 feet tall (420 to 480 cm), and had 20 to 22 inch long feet (50 to 55 cm). His or her finger tips, with arms to their sides, would be about 6 feet (2 meters) above the ground.

This fossilised 12 foot 2 inch (365 cm) man, with a chest girth of 6 feet 6 inches (195 cm) and arms 4 feet 6 inches (135 cm) long, was dug up in County Antrim, Ireland. This photograph was taken at the London and North-Western Railway Company's Broad Street goods depot. It was propped up for viewing against a 19th century railway carriage. It totally dwarfed the railway carriage.

After a discovery of giant human remains in Saudi Arabia in 2000, pranksters appended the following two doctored pictures to the report, in order to discredit the find.
